

Performing on prominent stages all over the world, Dr. Maya Tuylieva has been described by colleagues and listeners, as a profound artist who commands the attention of the audience with her inimitable sincerity and conviction.

She won her first competition at the age of six and made her national debut with a live performance on Turkmen National Television at the age of eight.

Maya is a winner of numerous National and International competitions. In the spring of 2008, Maya Tuylieva won the Cosmo and Buono International Piano Competition in New York, NY.
